SPECIFIC TO THE POSITION: Knowledge in application development using Object-Oriented Programming. This entry-level position involves developing and coding Java/J2EE/EE web applications and the ideal candidate is preferred to have knowledge/experience with Java/J2EE/EE programming. Preferred background in the implementation of GIT, MAVEN, TomEE/Tomcat, and Oracle Exadata or any other design-related tools to gain efficiency is a plus. Working knowledge of the following technologies and IDEs such as HTML, XML, EJBs, Eclipse, IntelliJ, and NetBeans is preferable. Knowledge of Tools to integrate back-end systems with web-based applications is an additional plus. The candidate should be able to adapt to multiple roles on the development team and learn any of the needed tools to accomplish the Software Development Life Cycle (SDLC) of a project. Ability to function within the collaborative development methods of an experienced project team. Good verbal and written communications skills and be able to communicate effectively with stakeholders at all levels.

DESCRIPTION OF POSITION: Under direct supervision of a supervisor within the Application Development Division, the Software Development Specialist 1, OIT will assist in advancing the State Payroll System into a web-based environment. Will prepare test data and documentation for all test environments: unit, integration, and system testing. The ideal candidate should be able to adapt and learn new web tools and technologies, enhance skills, share knowledge, and acclimate to an ever-changing web environment.

REQUIREMENTS:

EDUCATION: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree.

EXPERIENCE: One (1) year of programming, systems analysis or computer analysis experience.

NOTE: Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute additional experience as indicated above on a year-for-year basis with thirty (30) semester hour credits being equal to one (1) year of experience.

NOTE: A Master's degree in an Information Technology field may be substituted for one (1) year of the indicated experience.

LICENSE: Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

FOR NON-U.S. CITIZENS AND/OR FOREIGN DEGREES
